


Getting Started

Experiverb





Introduction

Experiverb is a modern experimental reverb plugin which includes 8 different spaces of algorithmic reverb.

Quick Start

Double-click the installer found inside the main Experiverb folder and follow the instructions.

For Windows users: During the installation you may select the formats you want to be installed (VST, VST3, AU, AAX)

Authorization

The first time you open Experiverb, a window will pop-up, asking you for your registration email.

Enter your email to authorize Experiverb and click Unlock.

Depth

```
HOLD LEFT CLICK AND - MOVE UP/DOWN
```

Click Experiverb's central shape (graphic) and drag Up or Down to adjust the Depth of the reverb.

You can see its amount here:



Shape

Right-click the central shape and drag Up or Down to select another shape. This selects another space of the reverb to apply.

You can see the number of the selected shape here:



Dry/Wet



The Dry/Wet slider adjusts the amount of the Reverb (drag up/down).

The more its amount is, the more reverb you'll have.

Oppositely, the dryer the track, the more forward the sound will be.

Freeze



The Freeze button freezes the reverb, adding continuous sustain to it.

Click here to save your preset:




Enter a name for your preset and click Save:
