ACOUSTICS 101 Cheat Sheet

Acoustics is **not** just theory.

There are some very practical applications that will help you make better-sounding, more professional recordings & mixes immediately, with the gear you are already working with.

Bass trapping always helps a lot.

The more bass traps you put in the corners of a room (including wall/ceiling corners), the better the room will sound. The smaller the room, the more important this becomes.

Absorb early reflections.

In general, early reflections are your enemy, whether you are listening to your monitors tweaking a mix or placing a microphone. Using good absorbers at nearby reflection points makes a huge improvement to your sound.


